2012-2013 ACADEMIC YEAR GRADUATE TEACHING ASSISTANTSHIPS

The School of Information Sciences awards several graduate teaching assistantships to qualified students who are fully admitted as potential degree candidates prior to the award date.

Graduate teaching assistantships are appointed for two consecutive semesters beginning in the fall semester of an academic year (Fall, Spring). Full-time enrollment (a minimum of 9 hours) is required each semester and a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 is required during the two semester appointment. Applicants who begin the program prior to the appointment must have a minimum of 18 semester hours remaining to complete the degree at the effective date of the appointment.

The assistantship is a one-fourth time academic year appointment that requires a normal work time of 10 hours per week for each week that the university is in session during the tenure of the assistantship.

Graduate teaching assistants are appointed primarily to perform various types of duties associated with faculty preparation for instruction. Any assigned instructional activity is conducted under careful supervision. The annual stipend is approximately \$6255 payable in twelve monthly installments on the last working day of each month beginning August and ending July. In addition to the stipend, the graduate teaching assistantship provides a waiver of in-state or out-of-state maintenance/tuition fees for three semesters (Fall, Spring, Summer), but there are no assigned duties during summer semester. The assistantship does not cover in-state or out-of-state charges for the programs/services fee, facilities fee, or the technology fee, the cost of books and materials needed for courses, housing, and graduation fees.

The deadline for submitting the application is March 1 of the year of the award. To be eligible for consideration, applicants must complete the SIS admission process and receive confirmation of the potential degree status.

Applicants for the graduate teaching assistantships are notified by May of the year of the award.
